## 3. Approve Meeting Minutes of February 7, 2024:

Motion to approve the February 7th minutes with correction to next meeting date Jim motioned to approve the minutes with change; Pat seconded. All in favor.

## 4. Green Team updates

Activities that CTEC manages are all part of the Green Team: clean ups, gardens, plant sales and tree seedling giveaways, educational webinars/meetings, etc. Silver Certification received October 2021. We are up for recertification in 2024. Application dates to focus on are May 10<sup>th</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup>. 2024 Sustainable Jersey (SJ)Team members/subcommittee: Jessica Romeo and alternate commissioner Pat Wells.

There was a discussion about other ways to capture SJ points:

- -Art in the community. Amy Mason will pursue with the Borough about opportunities to collaborate.
- -the Township has been helping with the Friends of the Library Book Sale;

- -we are getting ready to launch Adopt-a-drain for March 2024;
- -CTEC has worked with DPW to provide some educational materials to the K-3 schools in the SDOC around recycling and waste;
- -the anti-idling campaign will again be promoted at CHS and perhaps LAF in the Spring; Jessica is meeting with the CHS Environmental Club;
- -ideas for the "Healthier Communities" component;
- -we are set to host Native Plant month with the Library of the Chathams in May of 2024.

220 Points were submitted on Feb. 24, 2024 application deadline. The goal is to submit at least a total of 350 points for the May 10, 2024 deadline.

Progress is being tracked on an excel document 'CTEC Sustainable Jersey 2024 Tracker'.

# 5. NRI Update

(Subcommittee Lisa, John, Jessica). CTEC to make suggested updates to each section identified as needing updates and share with Township engineer for advice and input. Must consult the Planning Board who needs to include the NRI in the 2027 Master Plan. Relationship with Drew University in assisting with the updates in Fall 2024 needs to be reevaluated.

# 6. Adopt-a-Drain program

Adopt-a-Drain is a not-or-profit organization that helps towns introduce this program to their residence. They provide maps of where the drains are located, a welcome packet and a report back to the DPW providing a metric to track progress: # of drains adopted, # of participants and amounts of debris collected. Program will begin as soon as possible. Recent delay caused by the lack of geodata on each drain. The geodata is currently being manually entered.
