The Chatham Township Environmental Commission's goal is to provide a responsible environmental viewpoint to Township committees and boards and to undertake projects with a strong educational component in order to inform officials and residents about constructive actions that can be taken to preserve the environment.

2. Public Meeting Statement and CTEC's Purpose (see above)

3. Approve Meeting Minutes of March 6, 2024 and April 10, 2024:

Motion to approve the minutes of March 6, 2024 and April 10, 2024 Jim motioned to approve the minutes; John seconded. All in favor.

4. Green Team updates

Activities that CTEC manages are all part of the Green Team: clean ups, gardens, plant sales and tree seedling giveaways, educational webinars/meetings, etc. Silver Certification received October 2021. We are up for recertification in 2024. After conversations with Township Committee members and Township Administration, it was agreed the current goal is a Bronze certification because of limited resources in completing the lengthy application. Application dates to focus on are May 10th and July 31st. 2024 Sustainable Jersey (SJ)Team members/subcommittee: Jessica Romeo and alternate commissioners Pat Wells Jim mentioned a sneaker drive that the Senior Citizen Center may qualify for points. Jessica asked Jim to follow-up with documentation.

220 Points were submitted on Feb. 24, 2024 application deadline. Progress is being tracked on an excel document 'CTEC Sustainable Jersey 2024 Tracker'.

5. Native Plant Ordinance

The committee reviewed the draft and offered comments. Jessica will incorporate comments. The ordinance is on the Township Committee Workshop agenda tentatively for 5/7/24.

6. Chatham Township Tree permitting process and tree replacement discussion.

The committee discussed the current permitting process and tree replacement ideas. Lisa has done a comparison by towns and wants to pursue a comparison to any state ordinance. Lisa also described the idea of a Tree Bank being used in some towns. All agreed that follow-up is a critical component of any future changes.

7. Adopt-a-Drain program

Adopt-a-Drain is a not-or-profit organization that helps towns introduce this program to their residence. They provide maps of where the drains are located, a welcome packet and a report back to the DPW providing a metric to track progress: # of drains adopted, # of participants and amounts of debris collected. The program has been launched. Residents can sign up at https://nj.adopt-a-drain.org. The committee agreed there is a need to engage the community and encourage participation. Information will be included at future events such as Fishawack and any fair or festival CTEC attends. Information will also be sent to the Courier.

8. Fishawack Festival

The committee confirmed their interest in attending. There will be Mosquito Dunks, information on Adopt-a-Drain, a simple craft, and overall awareness of all that CTEC does in the community.

9. Shunpike Restoration Project

CTEC has consulted with Jean Epiphan from the Morris County Extension Service as well as two Rutgers Stewards. ANJEC Open Space grant application was submitted on April 24th. A grant application has been submitted to the Jaycees for signage for this project as well as native plant garden signate.

10. NRI Update

(Subcommittee Lisa, John, Jessica). CTEC to make suggested updates to each section identified as needing updates and share with Township engineer for advice and input as appropriate. Must consult the Planning Board who needs to include the NRI in the 2027 Master Plan.

11. Pollinator Pathway Project for Municipalities

Amy will look into what is involved. Discussion expanded to included the widespread use of Mosquito Sprays on yards and the role of the Morris County Mosquito Commission. The question was also raised as to whether the Township continues to use organic turf products.
