WHEREAS, the NJWCPS awarded Contract B414-13 to Longo Electrical Mechanical, Inc., One Harry Shupe Boulevard, PO Box 511, Wharton, New Jersey 07885 ("Longo"), for the purchase of various manufacturer pumps and motor repairs, replacements, and installation; and

WHEREAS, the Township needs to purchase a vertical turbine pump as specifically set forth in quote No. 45243 from Longo, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, pursuant to NJWCPS Contract B414-13 in an amount not to exceed Thirty Nine Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$39,260.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer of the Township has certified that adequate funds for such a purchase are available.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that:
