

RESOLUTION 2026-110

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITATION OF BIDS FOR MILLING AND RESURFACING OF RIVER ROAD IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATHAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL PUBLIC CONTRACTS LAW

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq. (the "LPCL"), the Township of Chatham (the "Township") desires to solicit bids for an operator for the milling and resurfacing of River Road from Fairmont Avenue to Passaic Street in the Township of Chatham (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the cost of the Contract will exceed the bid threshold, which requires the Township to conduct public bidding in accordance with the LPCL; and

WHEREAS, the Township received a grant from New Jersey Department of Transportation (the "NJDOT") Municipal Aid Project in the amount of \$252,707 (the "Grant") to utilize in connection with the Project; and

WHEREAS, Project plans and specifications were prepared and submitted to the NJDOT for approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. Subject to prior approval by the NJDOT, the Township Committee hereby authorizes the Township's Qualified Purchasing Agent, under the direction of the Township Administrator and in consultation with the Township Engineer and Township Attorney, to prepare bid specifications in accordance with the LPCL for the Project.
3. The Township Committee hereby further authorizes the Township Clerk, once the NJDOT authorizes the Project and the bid specifications have been prepared, to solicit bids pursuant to the LPCL for the Project, subject to receipt of the Grant.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
