

RESOLUTION 2026-131

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATHAM AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITATION OF BIDS FOR WET SLUDGE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL PUBLIC CONTRACTS LAW

WHEREAS, the Township of Chatham's current contract for the transportation of wet sludge from the Township of Chatham Water Pollution Control Plant to the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission expires on November 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq. (the "**LPCL**"), the Township of Chatham (the "**Township**") desires to solicit bids for the transportation of wet sludge from the Township of Chatham Water Pollution Control Plant to the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission for the period of December 1, 2026 through November 30, 2029, with two optional one-year renewals (the "**Project**"); and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the cost of the Contract will exceed the bid threshold, which requires the Township to conduct public bidding in accordance with the LPCL.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Township Committee authorizes the Township's Qualified Purchasing Agent and Township Clerk, under the direction of the Township Administrator and in consultation with the Township Engineer and Township Attorney, to solicit bids pursuant to the LPCL for the Project.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
