**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
CHATHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING
CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 FOR THE LAFAYETTE AVENUE AND SPRING STREET
SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham (the "**Township**") previously awarded a contract to AA Berms LLC for the Chatham Safe Routes to School – Lafayette Avenue and Spring Street Project (the "**Project**"), Federal Highway Administration Project No. HSP-7937(101) CON, NJDOT Job Code No. 6057306, RVE File No. 1405T001 (the "**Contract**"); and

WHEREAS, Remington & Vernick Engineers, Inc., on behalf of the Township, has recommended Interim Change Order No. 1 (the "**Change Order**") to revise the Contract documents to conform with changes in federal law resulting from the issuance of Federal Executive Orders 14151 and 14173 and the revocation of Federal Executive Order 11246; and

WHEREAS, the Change Order incorporates revisions required as a result of the issuance of Federal Executive Orders 14151 and 14173 and the revocation of Federal Executive Order 11246 by deleting Federal Aid Attachment #3, "Requirements for Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity on NJDOT Federal Aid Projects," from the Contract documents; and

WHEREAS, the Change Order does not change the Contract price, does not change the scope of the Project, and does not result in an extension of the Contract completion date; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to authorize the Change Order, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham in the County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein by reference as if set forth at length.
2. The Interim Change Order No. 1 to the Contract with AA Berms LLC for the Chatham Safe Routes to School-Lafayette Avenue and Spring Street Project is hereby approved. The Mayor, Township Administrator, Township Engineer, and such other Township officials as may be necessary are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Change Order and take any actions necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
3. The Change Order results in no increase or decrease to the Contract amount and no extension or reduction of the Contract time.
4. If any part of this Resolution shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereby shall not affect the remaining parts of this Resolution.

5. A copy of this Resolution shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Township Clerk.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

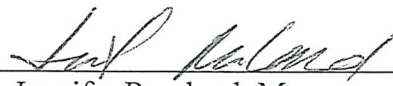
