

RESOLUTION 2026-163

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FLASHING PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD AND LAFAYETTE AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Township of Chatham desires to install pedestrian-activated 24/7 flashing LED pedestrian crosswalk signs at the intersection of Southern Boulevard and Lafayette Avenue, which are County roads, to improve public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Chatham has received through the Somerset County Co-op Quote QT40274 from National Highway Products (attached hereto as Appendix A) in the amount of \$9,626.05 for the signs; and

WHEREAS, the cost will be split between the Township of Chatham and the County of Morris; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Chatham will install the signs and be responsible for ongoing maintenance and replacement costs related to the signs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The installation of pedestrian-activated 24/7 flashing LED pedestrian crosswalk signs along Southern Boulevard at the intersection with Lafayette Avenue by the Township of Chatham is hereby authorized.
2. The Township of Chatham shall be responsible for sign maintenance and replacement costs after installation.
